Suggested Course Guidelines

For most people learning on fixed keel boats and boats over 21 feet, we strongly suggest 3-4 days of instruction (the Basic Keelboat and Basic Coastal Cruising courses combined). These courses combined go well beyond the basics and contain information and tactics that those with some experience will find useful. We would only recommend the 2 day Basic Keelboat as a stand-alone course for dinghies and day sailors smaller than 21 feet. Refer to our website www.bbyc.com and go to the "Sailing School" page. Basic Keelboat Sailing

2 days for 2 to 5 students

Basic Keelboat & Coastal Cruising

3 days for 2 students

4 days for 3-5 students

Bareboat Charter Certification

2 days for 2 students

3 days for 3 to 5 students

Cruising Catamarans

2 days for students transitioning from a monohull 33' or larger

5 days for students transitioning from a monohull less than 33' or with limited cruising experience.



The reason we add a day of training when more students are on-board is to allow ample time for repetition when practicing the drills. Many schools practice something once or twice then move on. We require that students practice a particular drill many times over and when a class stretches out over 3-4 days, chances are they will perform that training drill in different weather conditions which furthers the experience.
